

From the President...

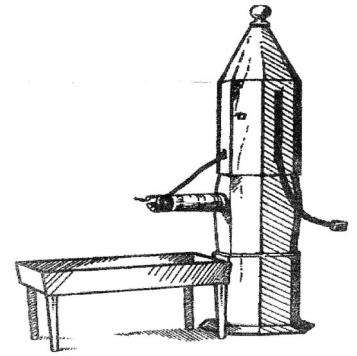
